#### UT AUSTIN STUDENT SURVEY ON THE CAMPUS CARRY LAW

Over a four-week period (February 7–March 4, 2019), the survey was administered in 23 courses, ranging from small seminars to large lectures, some of which had multiple sections. Professors allowed the researchers to introduce themselves, the goals of the project, and the anonymous nature of the data collection. The students had 15 minutes to complete the survey under the supervision of the researchers, who ensured that students did not engage in conversation or discuss the survey. Students were able to fill out the survey online by using their smartphone, tablet, or laptop; those without such a device were provided with a paper copy, whose results were later input into the electronic database.

Students were provided with the following information on the research project and survey:

"This is a survey about your experiences with the Texas 'Campus Carry' gun legislation (SB 11). We ask you to reflect on the impact of the legislation on your day to-day activities and everyday surroundings. For the study to be successful, it is very important that all the students selected for the research sample respond to the questionnaire. By participating, you help us ensure that the results of the study are representative.

This survey is being conducted by the John Morton Center for North American Studies at the University of Turku. Participation in this survey is entirely voluntary and it can be completed only once. All results of the study will be represented in statistical tables and charts and therefore individual students' responses cannot be identified. No identifying information will be collected, and all data is anonymous.

After the data has been collected and analyzed, it will be archived at the Finnish Social Science Data Archive (FSD). The estimated length of the survey is 15 minutes."
